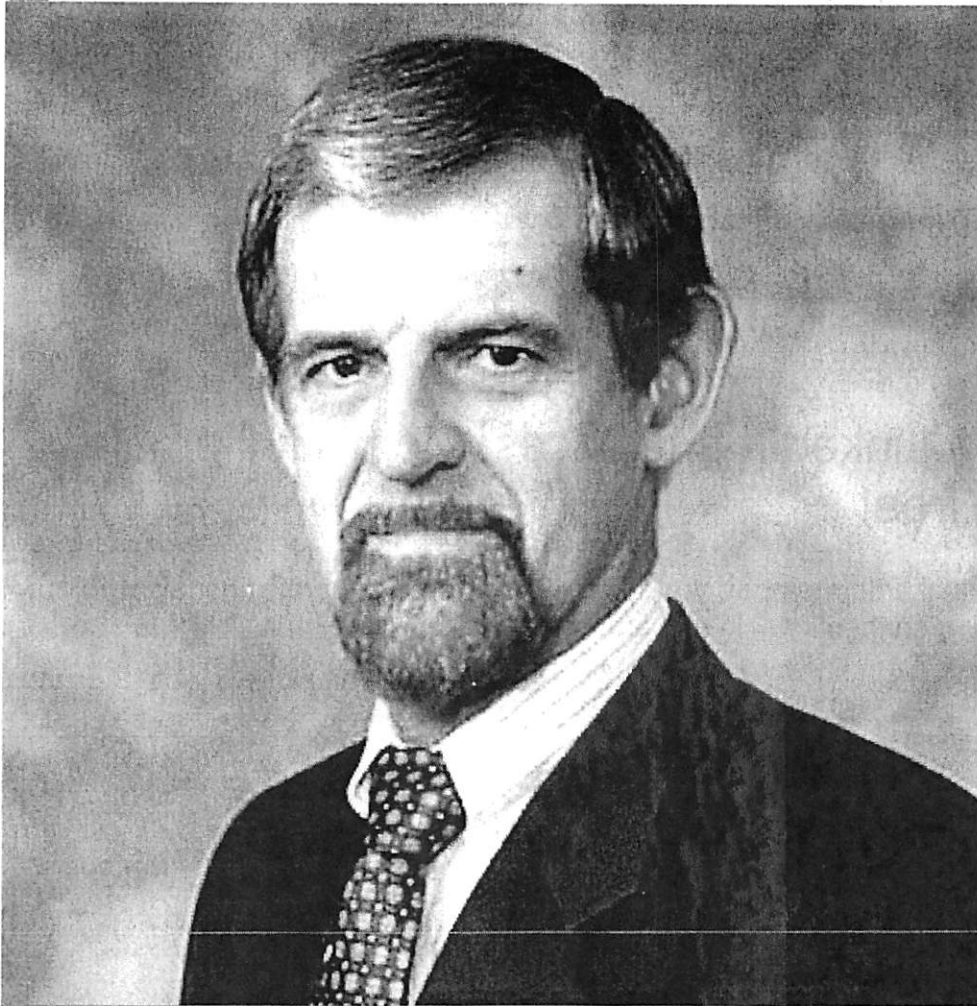
Laura and Cheryl, Can you please call me. 319-384-0714.

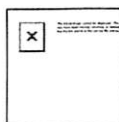

I did further checking and was informed that when it learned of the meeting, the President's office contacted University Human Resources because the meeting was related to the TIER initiative. Human Resources contacted the public library and learned the names of the people who reserved the meeting room. HR was able to speak with one of those individuals who shared few details about the reason for the meeting or why he was involved. Pappas Consulting also confirmed that it did not employ anyone named Thomas Dewey, one of the individuals who had been identified as a meeting organizer and Pappas employee. This raised some concerns and Teresa Kulper, Director of UI Organizational Effectiveness and Threat Assessment team member, contacted Det. Hotchkin. Det. Hotchkin then offered to attend the meeting.
